## 2014 STATISTICAL PROFILE FOR WICHITA

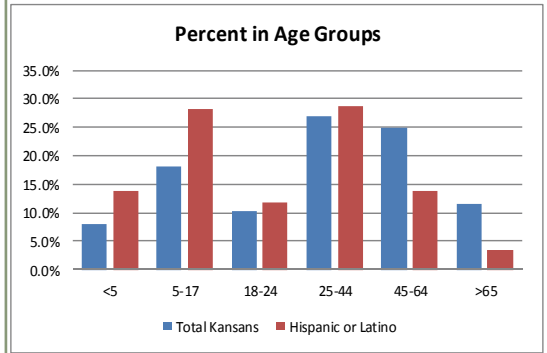
### DEMOGRAPHIC AND ECONOMIC

**59,358**

The estimated Hispanic population of Wichita. This is 15.5% of the city's population. Hispanic Americans account for 10.9% of the total Kansas population.

**47,544**

There are 47,544 more Hispanic Americans in Wichita today than in 1980. That is a 402.4% increase, compared to a 21.1% increase in the total number of Kansans during that period.



**48.6%**

Percentage of Hispanic Americans in Wichita who own their home.

**41.9%**

Percentage of Hispanic children in Wichita under 18 years who live in poverty, compared to 25.7% of all children in Wichita.

**817**

The number of Hispanic-owned firms in Wichita, with receipts of \$319,530,000.

**42.1%**

The percent of the Hispanic population in Wichita under age 18, compared to 25.1% of the general Kansas population.

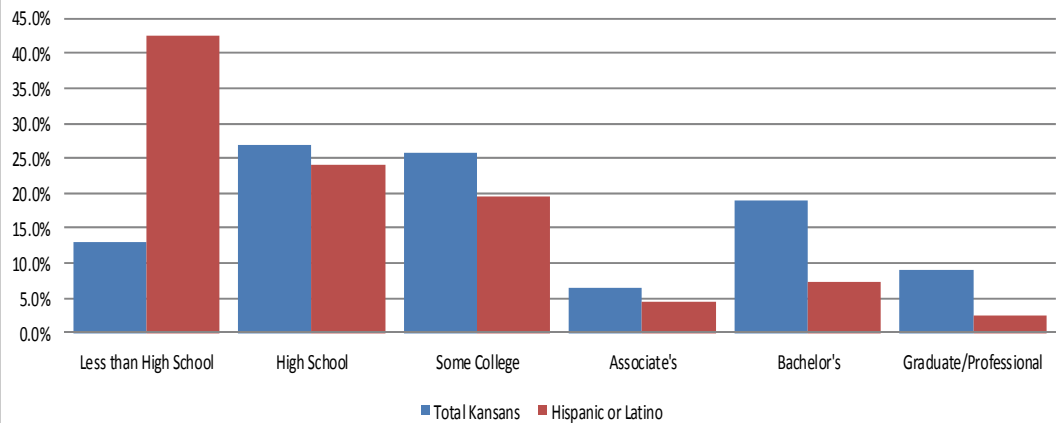
**22.6**

The median age of Hispanic persons in Wichita. The median age for all people in Wichita is 34.2 and 35.9 is the median age for all Kansans.

**1,987**

The number of Hispanic Kansans in Wichita 65 years of age or over, 56.2% are women.

The graduation rate for Hispanic high school students in Wichita USD 259 for 2012-13.

**32.2%**

Percentage of students enrolled in Wichita USD 259 who are Hispanic American during the 2012-13 school year.

**5.4%**

Percentage of Hispanic Americans in Wichita who are enrolled in college or graduate school, compared to 7.1% for all of Wichita.
